Intermediate Tier (IMT)	The umbrella term used for Bed-based Intermediate Care, Home-based Intermediate Care and Reablement.
	The Intermediate Tier provides short-term support and involves NHS and social care services who work together
	to aid faster recovery from illness or surgery. IMT can prevent hospital admission, avoid premature admission to
	long-term residential care, support timely discharge from hospital and increase independent living.
Primary Care	Primary Care is often the first point of contact for people in need of healthcare, usually provided by
	professionals such as GPs, dentists and pharmacists.
Secondary care	Secondary Care is also referred to as 'hospital and community care'. It can either be planned, urgent or
	emergency care.
Self-care	The practice of taking action to preserve or improve your own health.
SOP	Standard Operating Procedure. A set of step-by-step instructions compiled by an organisation to help staff
